Dr Lee Howell

Lee Howell is a global leader in sustainability, education, and policy. As the Executive Director of the Villars Institute, he leads efforts to accelerate the transition to a net-zero and nature-positive economy through systems leadership and intergenerational collaboration.

He is also a Titular Professor at the University of Geneva, where he designed courses on the Fourth Industrial Revolution and Disruptive Technologies for undergraduate, master's, and executive MBA students. Additionally, he serves on the Board of Governors of the International Baccalaureate (IB), helping guide education programs that reach nearly two million students across 5,600 schools worldwide.

Previously, Lee was a Managing Director at the World Economic Forum (WEF), where he led programming for major global summits, including Davos, the Annual Meeting of New Champions in China, and the Sustainable Development Impact Summit. He also served as Senior Director for Asia and Editor-in-Chief of the WEF's Global Risk Report.

His career spans leadership roles at USAID, UNHCR, the Japan Society of New York, and CSIS, focusing on global policy and development. He is a Board Member at the EAT Foundation, working on food system transformation, and an Advisor to the Frontiers Planet Prize, which rewards breakthroughs in sustainability science.

Lee holds a PhD from the University of St. Gallen, where he continues to lecture on Disruption and Innovation.

Lise is a highly respected Executive Coach with extensive experience in organizational design and change management. She has held Chief of Staff roles in both the President's and CFO/COO's offices at the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD), where she played a key role in establishing the bank's first-ever Organizational Design function.

Since 2013, Lise has been deeply involved in change management, organizational development, and leadership transformation. Currently, she is the CEO of ProFound Consulting, a firm specializing in tailored, high-impact coaching programs designed to meet the unique needs of individuals and organizations.

Her coaching approach is centered around three key pillars of change management: leading self, leading others, and leading change.





Dr Miniya Chatterji was Chief Sustainability Officer of Jindal Steel & Power group of companies 2014 - 2017. Prior to that she was working at the World Economic Forum 2011-2014 in Geneva where she managed the WEF's Young Global Leaders Community in the Middle East, North Africa, and South Asia. Before that, Miniya was managing a Euro 200 million hedge fund in Paris for a few years. She started her career in finance at Goldman Sachs in 2006 in London. Earlier, Miniya worked as policy analyst with Jerome Monod, the Chief Counsellor to the President of France Jacques Chirac 2003 - 2006. Miniya is a Jury Member for the Million Dollar Global Teacher Prize and for The Circulars award that is given away each year at Davos. Miniya is a member of the parliament of Francophone writers. She is a columnist for The Indian Express and The Pioneer newspapers. Indian Instincts - essays on freedom and equality in India was Miniya's first book. The book was published by Penguin Random House and launched in India in March 2018, then in Switzerland, Singapore and Sri Lanka and is translated in Bengali and French languages. Miniya has a PhD from Sciences Po Paris. She was a research fellow at Columbia University and Harvard University. She is a Global Leadership Fellow alumna of the World Economic Forum.
